Pennerley Power
A community project to install a single wind turbine in rural Shropshire. All members live within 5km of the proposed location



Tetstill Community Hydro
One of our 3 hydro projects in the area, repowering an old mill and providing 20% of the power needed by the village of Neen Sollars from clean electricity



Marches Community Solar
An innovative project installing large PV solar arrays on community buildings. The owner gets cheap electricity and the community gets a steady income



Woolhope Dome Community Woodfuel
A Community Energy Services Company sourcing wood from local woodlands, turning it into high quality fuel and supplying boilers owned by the project in locations around the area
